NB: Orders are to be limited to 3 months supply or as prescribed by the special conditions listed overleaf.

Note: recommended limits have been indicated for most items. However, an additional quantity may be supplied in a small number of cases where the degree of incontinence is shown to require more than the indicated limits. In these situations, the prescriber will need to seek prior approval from DVA.

After the first request by the prescriber, the prescribed products can be ordered as required by the entitled person e.g. any amount up to 3 month supply of disposable pads.

Description of Items		
RAP Item	Description	Supply limit and duration
AD01	Draw Sheet - Absorbent, Waterproof Backing	Limit of 4 per year. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD02	Disposable Liners/Underpads (blue underlay)	Limit of 600 every 3 months. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD03	Catheter Drainage Bag (non-sterile/sterile) non-drainable i.e. overnight bags, only used once	Limit of 100 bags every 3 months. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD04	Urinal (with/without holder) (male and female)	Limit of 2 per year. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD05	Catheters - In-Dwelling (e.g. Foley)	Limit of 8 every 3 months. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD06	Continence Briefs long lasting	Limit of 10 every 6 months. Non-disposable and washable briefs. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD07	Continence Pads - Disposable	Disposable 'pull-ups' are considered to be pads and therefore the limit of 540 every 3 months applies. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD08	Urine Drainage Bottle - 4 litres (with connecting tubing)	Limit of 2 per year. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD09	Leg Bag (non-sterile/sterile)	Limit of 20 either non-sterile or sterile bags every 3 months. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD10	Penile Clamp	Limit of 2 per year. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD11	Catheters - intermittent (e.g. Nelaton)	As clinically required. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD12	Catheters - External (e.g. uridome/penile sheath/penile pouch)	Limit of 120 every 3 months. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD13	Urine Collection Bag Hanger	Limit of 1 per year. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD14	Waterproof Sheet (rubberised)	Limit of 2 per year. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD15	Continence Consumables	Limited to products on suppliers' product list. Includes sterile gloves, KY Jelly, sterilising agents, tubing and perineal/stoma cleansing products, sterile water and normal saline. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD16	Occlusive Devices (e.g. anal plugs)	Limit of 105 every 3 months. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD17	Sitz Bath	Item has been removed due to safety reasons.
AD18	Faecal Collector - Perianal	Limit of 120 every 3 months. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD19	Continence Briefs (Mesh/Stretch)	Limit of 25 per 3 months. Stretch, mesh, disposable briefs but can be washed/re-washed between 4-30 times before needing to be replaced. Used to hold either disposable pads (AD07) or washable pads (AD21) firmly in place. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD20	Pessary ring	Limit of 4 per year. Initially by LMO, S, and subsequent requests for supplies can be made by RN, CA or entitled person. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD21	Continence Pads - Re-usable/Washable	Limit of 18 every 3 months. Often used in conjunction with AD06 (long lasting continence briefs) or AD19 (continence briefs - short term). Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD22	Catheter Drainage Bag (non-sterile/sterile) - Drainable	Limit of 20 bags every 3 months. Entitled person education and follow-up should be undertaken to ensure that the entitled person is aware of the number of usages possible per bag e.g. change the bag once a week and not daily. For non-drainable bag see AD03. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD23	Catheter valves - Long Term	Limit of 4 per year. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.

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Description of Items continued..

RAP Item	Description	Supply limit and duration
AD24	Chair pads - waterproof	Limit of 2 per year. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken. A home assessment should be undertaken to determine suitability of chair being utilised and to identify potential falls risk. The entitled person may require an assessment of appropriate continence pad/product or consideration of item AD26.
AD25	Catheter valves - short term	Limit of 20 every 3 months. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken.
AD26	Continence Absorbent Mat - for beside the bed only	Limit of 2 per year. This mat may assist entitled persons with urgency and/or nocturia, particularly when moving from sitting to standing position. An appropriate continence pad/product may also be required. Functional and product assessments should be undertaken. A home assessment should be undertaken to assess and evaluate the entitled person's home environment for the purposes of determining whether products are required, and if so, establishing the most suitable type of product.
AD27	Muscle Stimulator for Continence Issues (includes appropriate electrodes and batteries)	Limit of 1 per person. Use of the muscle stimulator would be part of an overall management plan which includes a home exercise program and appropriate reviews. Instruction in use, prescription of exercise and continence education would be provided by a continence nurse or physiotherapist. Evaluation of the effectiveness of this type of intervention would be completed prior to recommendation of supply.
AD28	Replacement parts, repairs and accessories (relating to item AD27)	DVA accepts financial responsibility for items not covered under the warranty period.
